## JOE FROGGER COOKIES

I have had this recipe since 1972. It makes hugh cookies that are great.

<ul> <li>7 cups flour, sifted</li> <li>1 TBSP salt</li> <li>1 TBSP ginger</li> <li>1 tsp cloves</li> <li>1 tsp nutmeg</li> <li>1/2 tsp allspice</li> </ul>	$\left. \left. \right  \right.$	Sift together into a large bowl.
3/4 cup water 1/4 cup rum	}	Combine and set aside.
<ul><li>2 tsp soda</li><li>2 cups dark molasses</li></ul>	}	Combine and set aside.
1 cup shortening 2 cups sugar	}	Cream together. Add dry ingredients, water and molasses in two sections, blending well after each addition.

Chill dough. Roll 1/4" thick on a floured board. Cut with a 4" cutter. Bake on a greased sheet at 375° for 10 - 15 minutes.
